

MID-IOWA MUDHEAD ASSOCIATION, ANITA & ADAIR TRACKS OFFICIAL RULES & REGULATIONS

1. ALL RULINGS MADE BY MUDHEAD OFFICIALS ARE FINAL.
2. Only one driver and one passenger will be allowed per vehicle, while participating in our event. All drivers and passengers must be at least 18 years of age for Pro Stock, Modified & Outlaw. You should be prepared to prove your age with a valid form of picture identification. If you do not have your picture identification you can not be in the vehicle. The ONLY exception is the Street Stock, the driver can be 16 or 17 with a valid drivers license and their passenger will be their legal parent or guardian or grandparent. The 16 or 17 yr will have to show the valid drivers license. You will have a release form to fill out in Street Stock for the 16 or 17 yr.
3. Anyone purchasing a pit pass must be at least 18 years of age, unless accompanied by their legal guardian. That legal guardian will be held accountable, for all actions, of any minor, that they have responsibility for. The Pit Area is dangerous, and not to be considered a Tiny Tots playground. If we find any children un-attended, anywhere in the Pit Area, your family will be asked to leave the event immediately.
4. All drivers and passengers must remain sober during the event. Any participant caught consuming any type of alcoholic beverages or illegal substances during the event will be immediately disqualified.
5. No alcohol on the track or in the staging lanes.
6. Please leave your ATV's at home! ATV's will be in use by the Mudhead Official's Only.
7. Pit area seating is first-come, first serve, and there is only 2 assigned spots (one for food and one for fire dept.). The pit area bleachers will be roped off for pedestrians only. Shade tents will be allowed inside the roped area, as long as they do not block the walkways in front of, or between, the bleachers. There is limited space for these tents.

8. Pit area parking is also first-come, first serve, and there are no assigned spots. Vehicles will be limited to one tools vehicle per race vehicle. (Only two vehicles per driver.) No trailers, will be allowed either inside the roped areas or parked anywhere near the roped area in the pits.
9. You must wear a helmet and seatbelt to drive or ride in this event. Helmets will not be provided.
10. Your vehicle must have working four wheel drive. There is an Outlaw exemption to this rule: If you have a 2-wheel drive vehicle, it will be up to a Mudhead Official to decide if your vehicle is eligible to compete in the Outlaw Class.
11. Your vehicle must have two working brakes. No exceptions!!
12. All race vehicles must have a designated area, in the front and rear, where our tow cable or chain can be attached. Examples of this would be a ball hitch, clevis, tow hook, or a one foot tow chain attached to the frame. This will insure a safe and speedy recovery of any vehicle stuck in the mud. Vehicles will not be allowed to register without these items.
13. Your registered number must be visible to all Mudhead Officials in the staging lanes and from registration. You will not be allowed to leave the staging lanes and proceed to the start line, until your number is moved to an appropriate position.
14. Only registered drivers are allowed to participate in our events. There will be no "driver swapping" in any vehicles. Your number is registered to you, in a certain class, not to the vehicle itself. If you did not register for the day's events, you should not drive during the days events. Breaking this rule, will result in a disqualification for both the driver and the passenger.
15. You must finish the race day in the same vehicle that you start racing in. You will not be allowed to switch vehicles, if the registered one breaks down.
16. Rolling starts will no longer be allowed under any circumstances. All races will start, from a stand still, at the start line.

17. You must give a hand signal or wave (No head movement) to the flag man starting the race, to acknowledge that you are staged and ready to start.
18. You must stay within the boundaries for your lane. All boundary disqualifications will be at the discretion of the Mudhead Officials. And remember, NO ARGUING!!
19. You must enter the staging lanes, immediately following your completed race run. If you are in need of repair, and need to head to the pits, you must alert a Mudhead Official, so that they may "HOLD" your spot in line. They will keep your place until it becomes your turn to race. You will automatically lose a flag, if you do not show up in time for your race. When it's your turn to race, and you aren't in line, YOU LOSE.
20. All drivers and passengers must keep their arms, hands and legs inside the vehicle at all times.
21. When you enter the staging lanes after a race, you must line up in the opposite lane. In other words, if you just raced in the grandstand lane, then you would line up in the pit lane. In the event that we have continuous wins in the same lane then every other driver will be pulled into the lane that you just competed in by Officials.
22. In case of a rollover one team member would be allowed to go to the track, to turn off the master switch and/or help get vehicle off the track, **IF** the driver and/or passenger were unable.
23. The object in the turn around is out of bounds, if you move it, you will be disqualified for that race.
24. If both drivers have a lane violation in the turnaround, they will both lose that race with the exception of a money/points round.
25. Idle speed in pits or you will be fined! The fine will have to be paid before you will race again. **WE WILL ENFORCE A FINE OF \$100.00.**
26. **Any truck that has rolled will be reinspected before it can be raced again. This includes going to other tracks.**

27. 2 false starts in the same race, you will automatically lose a flag.
28. Please put trash and cans in proper receptacles. Thank-you for your help.
29. All vehicles must be removed from the fairgrounds immediately after the end of the day's events.
